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## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT

























Joy and positivity have been difficult to sustain for many of us in 2020. But, at the STEM Alliance, we brought personal connection, and even laughter, to many as we provided families with critical services and engaging learning experiences such as *Virtual Mentoring*, outdoor *STEM Pods*, and *Digital Equity Now* device distributions. These services provide essential tech education while fighting Covid isolation – and are provided on an equal access basis to all families. **Since September 2019**, we have brought STEM enrichment to over 1,500 participants with 47% of those students being served between March and now. Additionally, we spent close to \$200,000 on scholarships for underserved population and subsidized programs to bring cutting edge STEM learning to the public. Now more than ever, our skills and services are in high demand and we need your support to meet ongoing needs.

As STEM education experts and innovators, we were better equipped than many to understand the technological struggle of low income clients. We used our experience and resources to create original programs for all students – and we did it at startup speed. In only six weeks this spring, we created an entire digital platform for the Co-Op Summer Enrichment program. This virtual camp trained and employed over 50 local young adults at a time when jobs were desperately needed. At Co-Op, almost 200 low income campers mastered digital fluency skills and logged over 25 hours of academic practice putting them on track for a more successful hybrid school year. As trailblazers, we are now offering support to other nonprofits across the County that are seeking to build their own virtual platforms.

This year, we saw that when uncertainty hits, our work expands because people quickly understand that STEM skills – lab sciences, coding, data management, and design thinking – can address both our current challenges and the unknown challenges of the future. We remain nimble, responsive and successful because we are financially supported by donors like you. Donors who know there is an urgent need to develop a workforce with breakthrough STEM skills; a workforce that can command higher wages and greater employability; a workforce that will lead to economic growth for our country.
